1. What is the question?

此篇論文在探討國家向美國購買武器後的影響。

2. Why should we care about it?

軍事力量對國家衝突的影響很大,購買武器確實會影響一個國家軍事的傾向 及類別,但現有的實證文獻卻很少。

3. What is the author's answer?

作者發現跟美國購買武器的國家會減少政治迫害(one-sided violence),但會增加 內戰的可能性(two-sided violence)。還有增強軍事力量不一定會增加或減少政治 暴力,但會改變國家對國內政治威脅的處理方式,內戰的次數也變多。

4. How did the author get there?

作者將國家區分成 political repression (one-sided violence)及 civil war (two-sided violence),藉由蒐集武器銷售及政治暴力的資料並個別分析來了解跟美國購買 武器會對國家造成什麼影響。
